1 Timothy 6:11-21

1. What did Paul tell Timothy to flee from?
2. Are you pursuing righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance, gentleness? If not, what are you pursuing? (2 Timothy 2:22)
3. How would you describe the “good fight of faith”? How would you know if you are winning the good fight? (Ephesians 6:10-12)
4. What is the “good confession”? (Matthew 16:15-20)
5. Paul asked Timothy to remain faithful to God’s commands until Jesus returns; does he ask us to do the same? Do you think Paul & Timothy were eager for the Lord Jesus to return?
6. How did Paul refer to Jesus in v 15-16? How close do you think Paul was to Jesus? Do you envy Paul?
7. What advice does Paul have for the rich? (Matthew 6:19-21)
8. Living in America, owning what we own, should we consider ourselves rich? Is it too easy to say that Paul’s advice is for the rich guy in Port Royal?
9. Do you have to be rich to be generous or rich in good deeds? (2 Corinthians 9:6-11)

10. How do we lay up treasures in Heaven?

11. Paul closes this letter by telling Timothy not to get side tracked on godless chatter or false knowledge or wisdom but to keep your eyes on Christ's work and mission. Isn't this good advice for every believer today? (2 Timothy 2:14-16)
