- 6) Why did King Herod have John the Baptist killed?
- 7) What attitude did King Herod have toward John the Baptist?
- 8) Who is actually behind the beheading of John the Baptist?

- 9) Why did King Herod allow John to be executed?

- 10) With the pressing crowds what is the concern for the disciples expressed by Jesus in v. 31?

- 11) How did Jesus and the 12 attempt to get away from the crowd?

- 12) How much would 'half a year's wages' be? (v. 37)

- 13) How many loaves were available?

- 14) How much leftover food was taken up?

- 15) How many men were fed from that meal of bread of fish?

- 16) Jesus walked on the lake and Mark says in v. 48, 'he was about to pass by them'. What do you think this means?

- 17) What is the reaction of the disciples when they see Jesus walking on the lake?

- 18) Explain v. 52 – '... their hearts were hardened.'
