**Daniel 6**

This story is similar to that of Daniel 3 - it also details a court conflict

Nebuchadnezzar is no longer king in Babylon

read chapter 4 – Nebuchadnezzar lost his sanity

replaced by his son, Belshazzar

fingers of a human hand appear and write on the wall

Belshazzar is killed and Darius the Mede takes over the kingdom

Daniel is in position to be one placed over all the kingdom

no short-comings or faults

Daniel's enemies appeal to the king's \_\_\_\_\_ and his new \_\_\_\_\_

the administrators and satraps went to the king as a group

where is Daniel? – he is one of the three administrators

v. 8 – the decree of the king is \_\_\_\_\_

Daniel continues his habit of regular prayer
