"Abraham Offers Isaac" - Genesis 22:1-19

Genesis 12 – the calling of Abram

Four-fold	promise to Abram	(Ahraham)
roul-lold	DIDITISE LO ADIAITI	(ADI allalli)

- 1. I will make you into a great nation
- 2. I will make your name great
- 3. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse
- 4. all peoples on earth will be blessed through you

Gen. 12:4 – Abraham the Lord
he was years old when he left his homeland
A problem with fulfilling the promise – Abraham didn't have any children
Some suggest this is a story of a monster god who requires child sacrifice – how do you counter that claim?
1. it fails to take seriously the context
2. it fails to read the of the wider story of Abraham
3. it fails to recognize the original audience had the law that prohib-
ited sacrificing children to God (Lev. 18:21, 20:2, Deut. 18:10)
Gen. 18:10 – Abraham has three visitors
leads to Gen. 22 – the birth of Isaac (Isaac means)
God speaks to Abraham – 'take your son, your only son' go to region of Moriah – near Jerusalem – 2 Chronicles 3:1, this is the mountain on which Solomon built the
How old is Isaac at this time? –
In v. 5 – Abraham tells the servants to stay here – "We will worship and then we will come back to you"

Is Abraham hiding what is about to happen? – is he expressing confidence that in some way God will bring back both he and Isaac? (Heb. 11:19)
Abraham loads the wood onto Isaac –
Isaac asks the obvious question – "Where is the lamb for the sacrifice?"
Isaac is bound and placed on the altar — Abraham had the knife in his hand
Why is Abraham's name called twice in v. 11?
"Now I know that you fear God" – was there some doubt about Abraham's fear of God before this? to fear God is to
Abraham assured Isaac that God would provide a lamb – God provides a did Abraham not see the ram before? – was the rain not there before?
the Lord will 'see to it' — the Lord saw to it — that Abraham and Sarah had a son that the ram was caught in the thicket that this happened on the mountain where the temple would be built that His Son Jesus died on the cross for our sins
