4.	Why would James think it was so important for us to look after widows or orphans? Isaiah 1: 15 – 17 Malachi 3:5
5.	Can I be like Jesus if I am only keeping his commands and not loving and serving others?

	motives and hearts. Are we in danger of doing the same things as we wall
	through the motions in church?

7. Read Micah 6:8 and Matthew 23:23. Your moral behavior is very important. How you adhere to Christ like lifestyle is an important but our concern for others and the condition of our hearts is a big priority with God.
