1. How can we apply the principle of "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven" in our daily lives?
2. Take a moment to reflect on **Romans 14:6-8, 17-18**. When we focus on promoting ourselves and pursuing personal recognition, how does it hinder us from experiencing righteousness, peace, and joy?
3. What do you think it means to let our light shine in order to glorify God and participate in his purposes? (Matthew 5:14-16)
4. What role does prayer play in seeking to do God's will, and how can we strengthen our prayer life to better align with Jesus' example?
5. How does the concept of God's will being done on earth as it is in heaven challenge our own desires and plans?

6. In what ways can we overcome our own selfishness and seek to prioritize God's will in all that we do, just as Jesus did? Read Matthew 16:24; Romans 12:2; Colossians 3:2

7. How can we support and encourage one another in our efforts to live in alignment with God's will, as Jesus would?

8. How does the phrase "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven" remind us of the importance of humility and submission to God's sovereignty? James 4:10

9. What are some practical steps we can take to bring about God's will in our own lives and in the world around us?

10. What role does the believer have in upholding God's name as holy, establishing God's rule in their life, and bringing about God's ultimate plan for the defeat of evil in both the present kingdom and the future kingdom? Read Ephesians 5:1, 17
