Lesson 1 - The Righteousness of God Revealed Book of Romans

1)	What is special about the gospel according to 1:1,2? List some Old Testament passages that promised the gospel.
2)	Discuss the different ways in which Jesus was declared to be the Son of God (v4).
3)	What was the objective of Paul's apostleship? (5). How does Paul's objective in his apostleship inspire or challenge you in your own life purpose or mission?
4)	Let's explore the significance of Rome in Paul's journey and why he was eager to go there (vv11-12).
5)	To whom was Paul obligated? Who do you feel a sense of obligation or responsibility towards in your own life and why (v14)?
6)	What is the power of God to save and how does that impact your faith journey (v16).

- 7) Why do you think it's important for us to understand and appreciate the power of God in saving us through His Son (v17)?
- 8) Let's dive into the ways in which God's attributes are revealed in nature and how that impacts our understanding of Him (v20).

9) How does God express His wrath? How does God's expression of wrath challenge or shape your perspective on justice and mercy (24, 26, 28)?

10) Explore the specific sin mentioned in the chapter as an indication of God's wrath and its implications for us today (26, 27).
