- 1. Had Paul ever visited Colosse or Laodicea? Why did Paul have such a concern for churches he had never seen?
- 2. In Colossians 2:2, Paul expresses a deep concern for the spiritual well-being of the church. How can we cultivate a mindset of intercessory prayer for other churches in our community and beyond? What specific ways can we support and encourage other congregations in their spiritual journeys?
- 3. What is the center of the Christian religion? Do religions or denominations try to operate without Christ as the head of their church?
- 4. Is Christ the source of all essential wisdom & knowledge?
- 5. Do you treasure the words of God? If so, how do you show it? (Matthew 6:19-21) (Psalm 119:129-136)
- 6. Reflecting on v4, can you share a recent example of a persuasive argument or popular belief that seems appealing on the surface but may conflict with your faith? How can we discern the validity of such arguments in light of Scripture?

- How does the Devil use these arguments or suppositions to weaken our faith? (1 Peter 5:8)
- 8. Jesus wants us to stay closely connected to Him. How do we stay rooted and buildup in Him? What kinds of things separate us from God?
- 9. The world is always full of attractive, deceptive philosophies. Can you name one that is popular today? (2 Corinthians 10:5-6)
- 10. Religious traditions can be helpful. Can you site some that can be harmful to a Christian's spiritual life?
