How does this perspective reshape our understanding of who 'God's chosen people' are? What implications does this have for our view of community and belonging within the faith? |
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| 2. | How do we know we are dearly loved?   |
| 3. | What are we to clothe ourselves with? Galatians 5:22-23   |
| 4. | Look at $v12$ - if we have taken these virtues as our own, how attractive will we be to the world?  |
| 5. | Have you had to bear with or forgive someone in the body of Christ lately? How many offenses did the Lord forgive you of when you came to Christ? Ephesians 4:32  |
| 6. | Tell us how love binds all these Christ-like characteristics together? Can I ever be an effective Christian without God's love in my heart?   |

| 7.  | Discuss what the peace of God is? Is the peace of God a lack of conflict or problems in our lives or is it something else? Ephesians 4:3 John 14:27       |
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| 8.  | Do you want the word of God to dwell richly in your heart? Psalm 1:1-3  |
| 9.  | When do we teach & admonish one another and sing hymns & Psalms & spiritual songs? Does that sound like gathering at church to praise & worship?          |
| 10. | Why do some Christians not see it necessary to go to church?  |
| 11. | Why is it important that we remember that what we're doing we are doing for Jesus? What motivates you to serve Christ & His church? 2 Corinthians 5:20-21 |
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
